## This past week 12th to 19th of March

In High St, night works have begun in the footpaths running between Nana's tea and Height of Health. Ducting and services have been installed in advance of a concrete protection slab being poured.

In O'Connell St works have been completed on the new manhole and the installation of services outside Boots. This area will now be backfilled along with the sewer works area between Cooks Lane and Quins Bow. Heras fencing between Boots and Quins Bow will be removed for the weekend to facilitate the crowds that are expected in town for the match between Limerick and Clare.













## Next week 22nd to 26th of April

In High St night works will continue with paving commencing on the footpath areas between Nana's tea and Height of Health.

Works are proposed to commence outside Hidden Hearing in O'Connell Square next Monday 22nd.

Rip and lay of the new sewer will continue between Quins Bow and Arthurs Lane. Currently we have completed 75% of the installation of the new sewer.

Paving between Dunnes Stores and the Old Ground Hotel on O'Connell St will continue in the carriageway. Works will commence on the footpath at Poets Corner. Access to premises will be maintained. Over the coming weeks the heras fencing in this section will be coming down and the area will be opened up. There will be more localised fencing erected to facilitate footpath works.
